From The Director

Summer 2015

I want to thank all of you for your prayers and words of encouragement during this difficult time. Many of you have asked for an update on my surgery and I wanted to respond...I just didn't know what to say as I waited on test results to come back.



As you know, I was diagnosed by a doctor in the States as having a hemorrhagic polyp on my vocal cord most likely due to overuse so on June 12th for the first time I went "under the knife" for what I was told would be a rather simple 30 minute surgery...and it was. However, the surgeon didn't

agree with the diagnosis made by the doctor in the States. Unfortunately, he was right...I had **pre-cancer**. Definitely not what I wanted to hear. The good news is that the pre-cancer has not spread and my voice is slowly returning to normal despite the inflammation from the radiation treatments.

I don't know what the root cause of the pre-cancer was. All I have right now is a doctor's opinion and two conflicting pathology reports but I do know **Who** allowed it to happen...Pain is a great teacher...it's instructional, it motivates us, purifies us, and most importantly, pain brings us closer to God. This has been the most difficult summer of my life...but I also know that God purposed my pain for His profit...

It was only two years ago that we had just one staff (Obed Simancas) to serve the city of Maracaibo and the surrounding areas. It took us another four months before we added another staff/volunteer in Kleber Cabrera and "just like that" we are now up to 24 staff and volunteers serving part-time and full-time in the FCA ministry. One of the "twenty four" is Yeimis Pineda. Yeimis started out as a volunteer Chaplain

much like the majority of our staff. He initially served three baseball academies and within the first two weeks five players accepted Christ as Lord and Savior and two started attending his church. Having that sort of impact that quickly was no doubt a great encourager for him and even though he has only officially been an FCA volunteer for about four months now, Yeimis has felt called to work

full-time in the FCA ministry and we couldn't be happier.
