One year ago our Community Ministry Director in Cali, Colombia; Ruben Chaves, left to start the FCA ministry in Riobamba, Ecuador. Since then, he has trained over 20 Chaplains to serve alongside him, built a team of coaches to serve in the ministry, and most recently organized a 3-Dimensional Training Seminar attended by 51 coaches. The Seminar was led by Mark Hull

with the 3D Institute and Roberto Medina. At the end of the Training, one coach stood up and said the following: *"We had to attend 16 different trainings last year mandated by the government and I learned more in this training than all the others combined."* We still have a long ways to go but I think you can see, God is at work in Riobamba through FCA.
